- A Canadian research lab that proposes an cooperation agreement with your University to support a common testing program of your model;





- A French research Lab that suggest to establish a common research group in Montpellier to draft an joint application to pursue your research within the framework of Horizon 2020/Europe;
- The Ministry of Defence from **North Korea** that offers an 5 years contract with an attractive salary (paid in euros) if you agree to move to Pyongang where you will be in charge of a research lab that will allow to launch the testing phase of your model.
