EQUIPMENT FOR CBRN TRAINING:

"Capacity building for medical preparedness and response to CBRN incidents"

- The Science and Technology Centre in Ukraine (STCU) is an international organization involved in the non-proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. STCU's mission is to support research and development activities for peaceful applications by scientists and engineers formerly involved with the development of weapons of mass destruction, to advance global peace and prosperity through chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear risk mitigation by supporting civilian science and technology partnerships and collaboration that address global security threats and advance non-proliferation.
- The STCU is currently carrying out Project 9817 (P 088): "Strengthening of CBRN Medical Preparedness and Response Capabilities in SEEE countries" which implemented to benefit the partner countries of the South East and Eastern Europe (SEEE) of the European Union's Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) Centers of Excellence Initiative (CoE). The overall objective of the project is to strengthen and enhance medical emergency preparedness and response capabilities in the SEEE region partner countries to ensure minimization of health consequences and human losses following the CBRN accident and/or emergency.
- The STCU (hereinafter referred to as the Employer), for purposes of Project 9817 (P088) is going to procure CBRN Protective Suits, medical and radiological equipment and materials, as well as consumables for training purposes. The full list of requested equipment and materials is described in the tender documents.
- The equipment shall be delivered to the recipients in Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Ukraine. The tender proposals could be submitted for one or more countries.
